

## **Cut Stencils**

This first project is to get you acquainted with the process, mixing and modifying inks, while also having you experiment with color, transparency, opacity and layering.

You will create a series of 10 prints, working with cut stencils. You will see a range of approaches

## **Requirements:**

Theme: Paper: Stencils:	Open High quality print paper, 11"x 14" or larger. (No newsprint or butcher paper). You must incorporate a minimum of 10 cut stencils.
You will be handing in a total of 10 prints. (2 prints representing each of the following)	
2 prints: 2 prints: 2 prints: 2 prints: 2 prints:	<ul> <li>Printing a single layer of stencils on dyed paper, spray painted stencils, or acrylic background.</li> <li>Printing stencils utilizing a blend roll for the background.</li> <li>Printing stencils in several layers, (Several runs through the press).</li> <li>Utilizing transparent layers, (incorporating several runs)</li> <li>Incorporating collage elements and hand drawing.</li> </ul>

## All prints must be turned in foamcore folder, labeled with your name on the outside.
