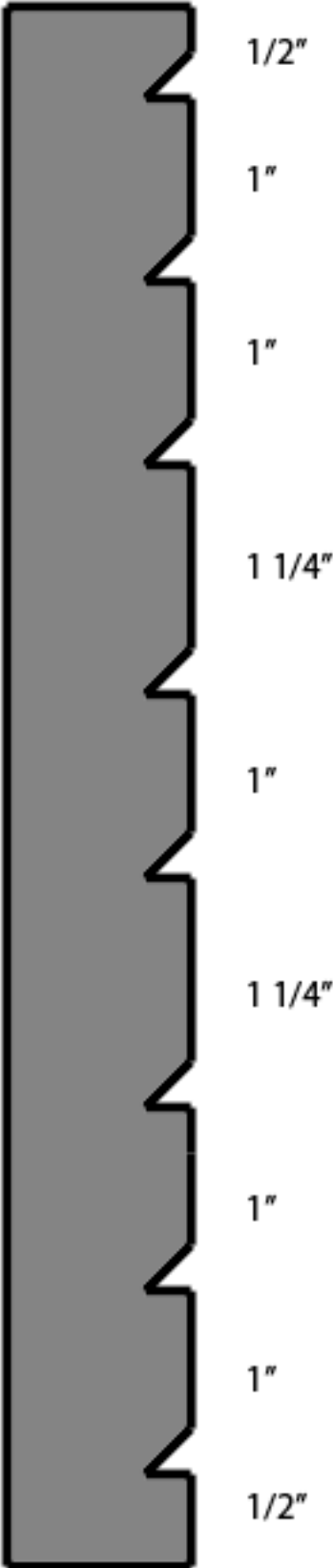


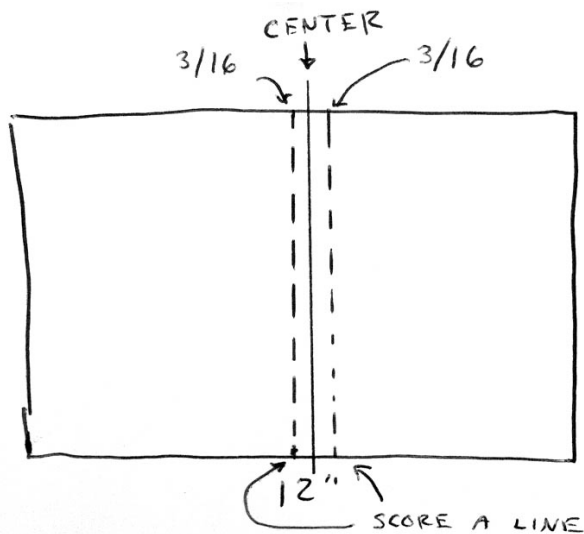
LONG STITCH (EVEN NUMBER OF SIGNATURES)

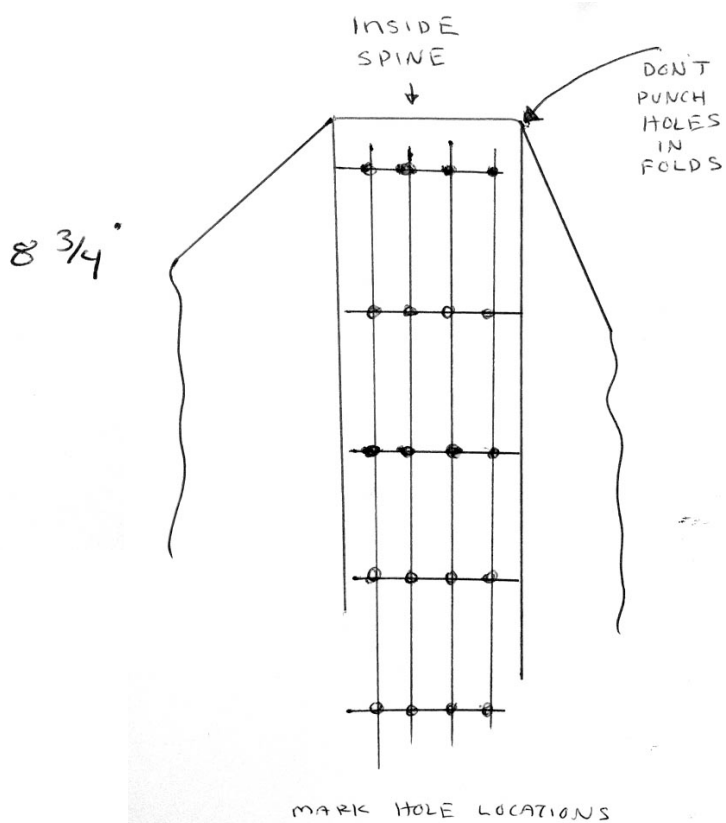
Step 1: Make a hole template.



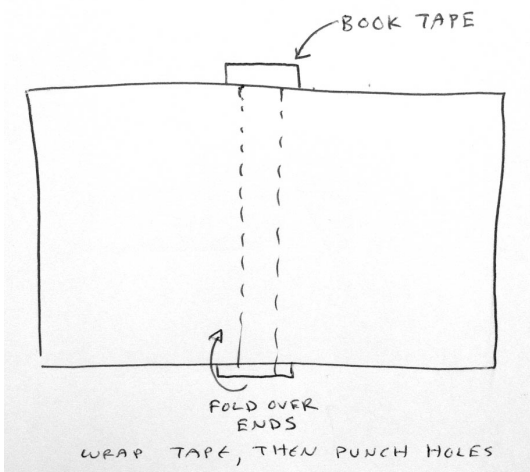
Step 2: Cut & score the cover.



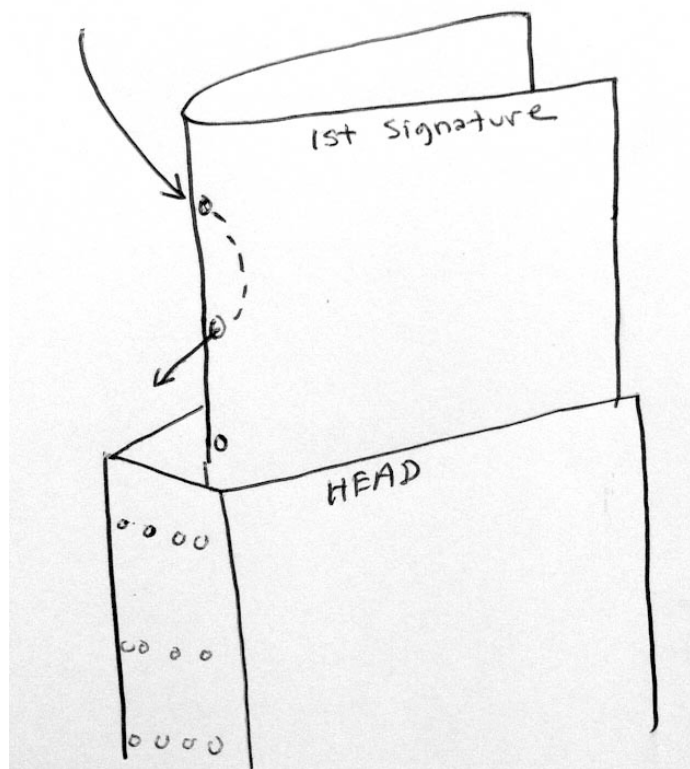
Step 3: Mark the spine holes on the inside of the cover.



Step 4: Cut booktape 1" longer than length of spine and attach. Then punch needle holes.

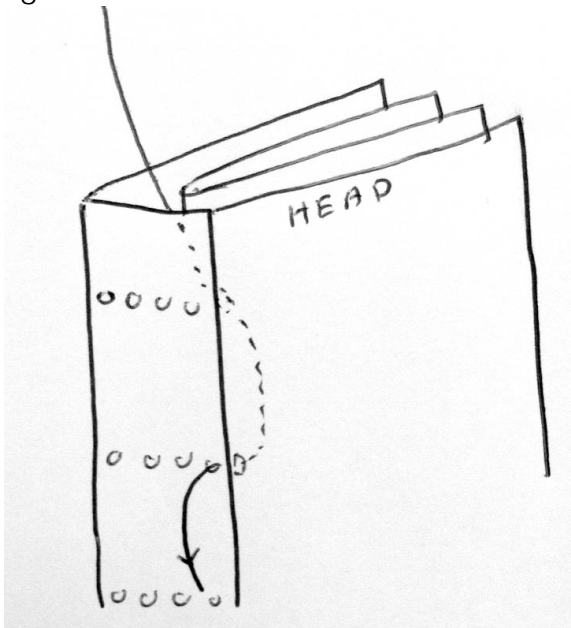


Step 5: Add the first signature. Begin on the outside of the top hole of the signature, go inside and out the second hole and then through the second hole on the cover.



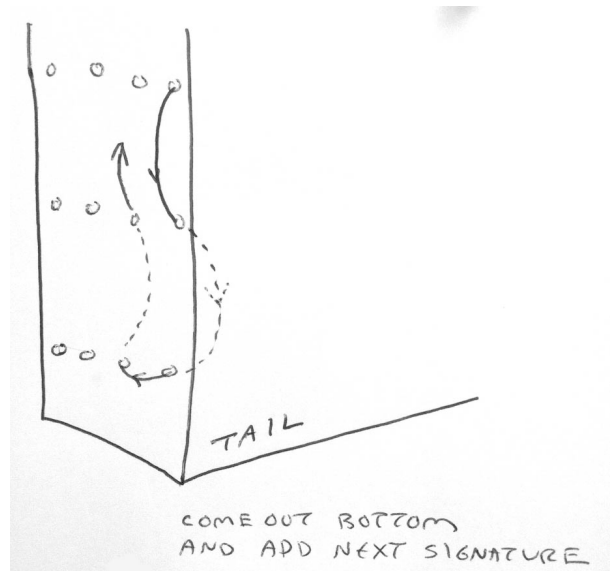
Step 6:

Come out second hole of spine and go down to third hole on the outside. Then into third hole and into signature.



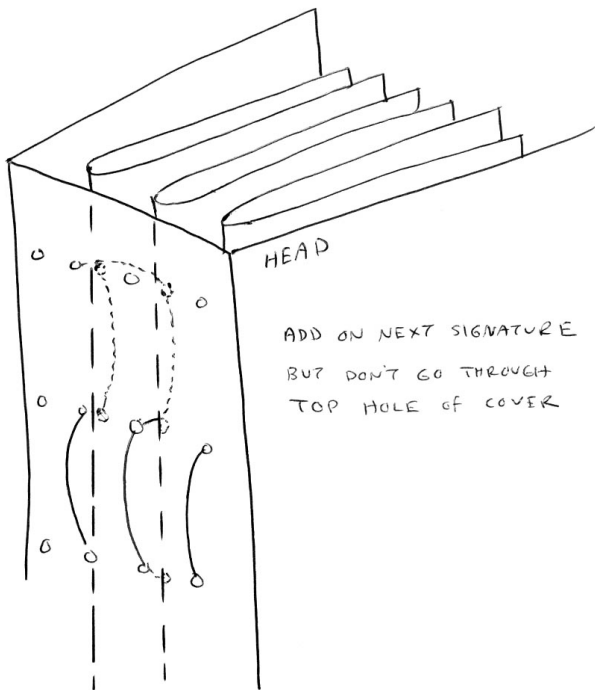
Step 7:

Come out the bottom hole, and into the next hole over. Add your next signature and continue up.



Step 8:

As you come out the top hole of the second signature, don't go through the cover, but instead add your third signature on, and go into the top hole and proceed down as usual.



Step 9:

After you've added on your last signature, come out the top hole on the cover, cross over to the next hole, go in, (loop around the threads between the two signatures) and come back out the next hole over until you've reached the start again, and then tie the two ends of thread together and trim.
